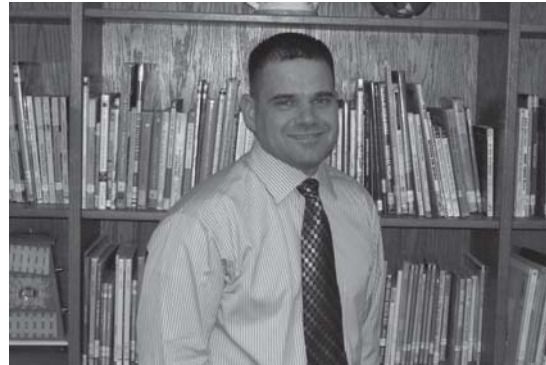

### THANK YOU FOR 25 YEARS OF SERVICE

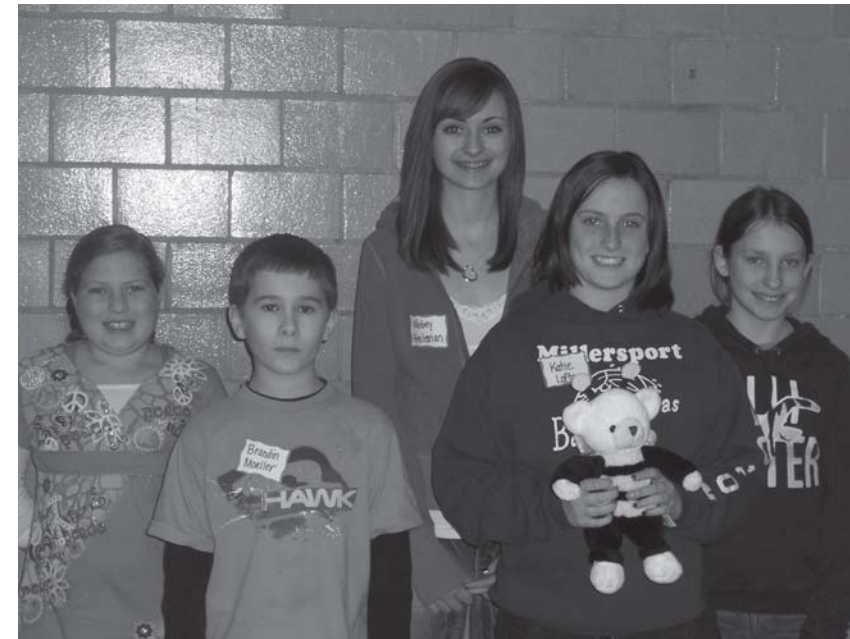
