

# Graduation Information

*A final senior letter will be mailed to you in May to confirm the various graduation details.*

Graduation will be held on Sunday, June 5<sup>th</sup> at 2:00PM in the Walnut Township District Auditorium. Each senior will receive ten tickets for the ceremony. If your family does not need all ten tickets, please return the extra tickets to the high school office. Extra tickets will be made available to families needing more tickets. Seats must be claimed by 1:40PM at which time the general public will be permitted to fill any unused seats.

Senior women need to wear white or very light colored dress pants and blouse or dress under their graduation gowns. Senior men need to wear a white or light colored shirt, tie, and dress pants. All graduates are expected to wear dress shoes. No tennis shoes! No jeans! No shorts!

Graduation practice is currently scheduled for Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup> beginning at 9:00AM. We will meet in the high school commons for attendance and then proceed together as a group to the district auditorium for practice. Be on time! **GRADUATION PRACTICE IS MANDATORY FOR ALL SENIORS INCLUDING VOCATIONAL STUDENTS!** If you do not attend practice you will not be permitted to take part in the graduation ceremony.

The graduation ceremony will begin at 2:00PM on June 5<sup>th</sup>. Seniors need to be in the elementary media center no later than 1:30PM. Be sure to bring your cap, gown and hairpins (if needed). All gowns will need to be pressed. BE CAREFUL!! The gowns are made of synthetic material that melts easily. Use a low temperature setting and a pressing cloth. Steamers also do an excellent job of removing wrinkles.

The senior picnic will begin following graduation rehearsal. (about 11:00AM). Parent volunteers will be needed to help with the picnic... set-up, serving, clean-up. Senior Slide Show will begin at 1:45PM in the high school gymnasium.

All school fees owed by seniors must be paid by Thursday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> (including lost uniform fees, lost library book fees, library fees, book damage fees, etc.). **If you have unpaid fees, you will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.** Please direct any questions about fees owed to the high school secretary Mrs. Teresa Nelson (467-2929). In addition, all vocational school fees must be paid by vocational school students.

Finally, all text books and library books must be returned and all final class assignments must be completed and turned in by Wednesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>.
